We kindly remind you to keep your paper between 2000 and 4000 words. For uniformity, we ask you to use the Chicago Manual of Style (17th ed.) as the preferred style guide. Additionally, please format your paper using a 12-point Arial font and maintain a 1.5 line spacing.

- 3. Click on 'Upload'
- 4. Drag & drop the file(s) to deposit.
